FBO Responsibilities continued

- Serve on appropriate Boards and Committees that are involved in the County's transportation services such as the United We Ride, CCWIB's Camden City Initiatives Committee, etc.
- Provide written reports to the TMCC operating structure (not yet defined) on a monthly or quarterly basis as needed.

TMCC (if funded) Responsibilities

- Keep a database of FBC providers' availability.
- Connect/schedule rider inquiries to the appropriate FBC provider.
- Share information on special driver trainings, i.e. safety.
- Provide technology for vehicles, i.e. Automated Vehicle Locator, Mobil Data Computer.
- Provide scheduling and billing support.

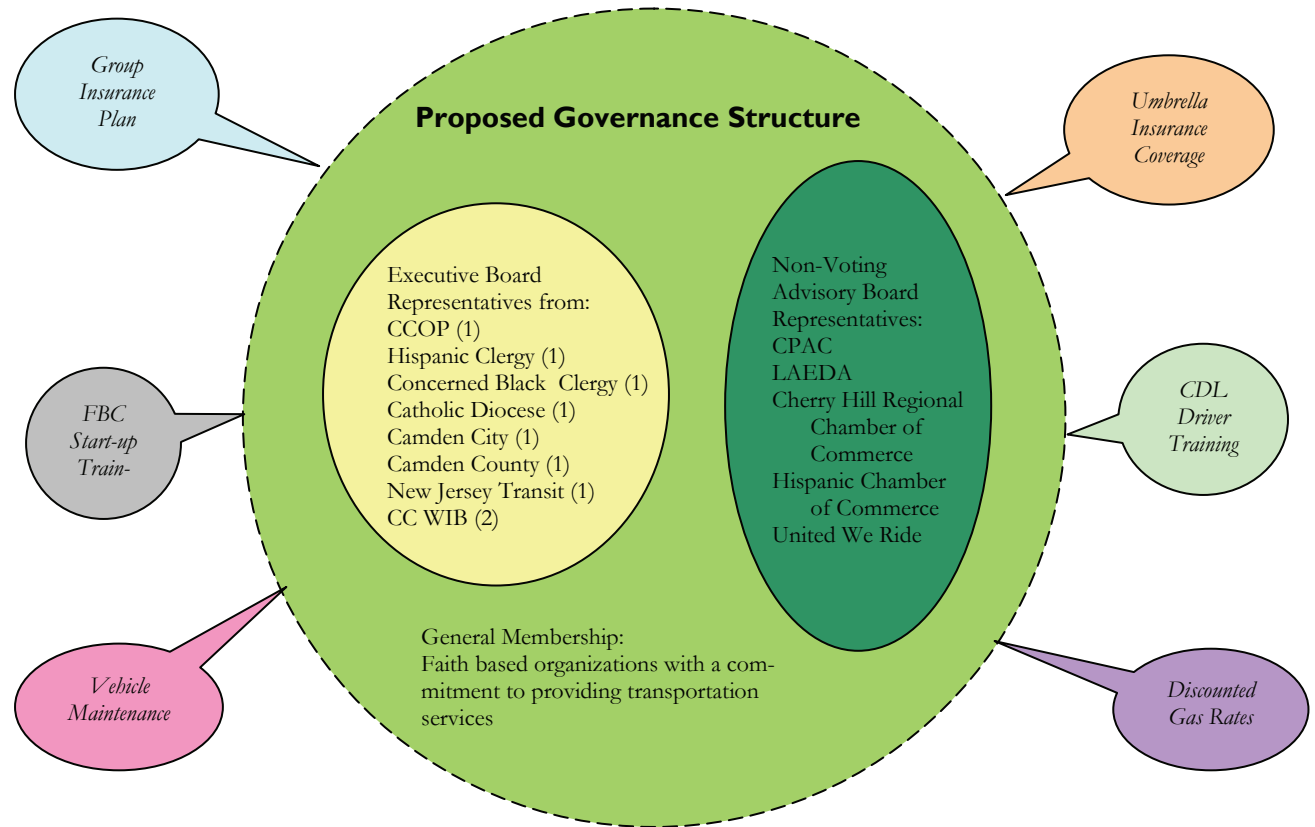
Community Transportation

The Faith Based Collaborative (FBC) will be made up of faith-based organizations providing transportation services to their community. Initially, the goal will be to work with each organization by providing assistance with defining the level of participation by type of service offered and time the services are available.

1. Types of service include:

- Door to door transport service: assist riders from their door to the vehicle and from the vehicle to the door of their destination (i.e. medical or social service appointment) and back
- Transit stop service: transport riders from home to bus stops and back
- To/From work services: transport riders from home to/from either work or SJTA cluster site and back, particularly at times when public transportation is not available or limited
- Senior shopping and recreation: transport seniors for group ride trips not covered by SenHan
- Human Services: provide transport for welfare recipients through the Camden County Board of Social Services.

2. Days and hours of service will be flexible and managed through a dispatch in the Camden County Travel Management Coordination Center (TMCC).



FBO Responsibilities

- Serve as the convener of the faith-based community's participation in the project, once operational.
- Identify and support participating faith based organizations (FBOs), particularly in the initial stages of implementing the project.
- Develop the Memoranda of Understanding/Non-Financial Agreements among faith based organizations that define their commitment to delivering services, reporting mechanisms, and other tasks associated with these activities.
- Establish clear procedures and processes that ensures full access and participation of the Camden County faith-based community in the TMCC.
- Function as the Fiscal Agent for all grants and foundation funds.
- Develop a mission statement and By-laws.
- Serve on appropriate Boards and Committees related to the implementation of the TMCC. *(Continued on back)*
