Empowerment Expo

The committee evaluated the recent Empowerment Expo, noting that while successful overall, community attendance was lower than anticipated. The timing and location for next year's event will be reassessed to improve attendance and impact.

Workforce Development Board

Jeff is working to see the following programs through to implementation:

- EMT Training Program - New initiative facing challenges with state approval for the eligible training provider list (ETPL)
- Aircraft Maintenance Technician Apprenticeship Program - Working through ETPL listing challenges

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- A UI Concierge Pilot Program has been proposed for the One Stop to improve service and reduce wait times

One Stop Career Center

Frank Cirii, Local Area Operations Director

The One Stop has served 13,143 customers over the past four months, averaging:

- 152 people per day
- 80 GED tests administered monthly

Work-First Requirement Changes

Frank highlighted significant changes to work-first requirements that will impact clients:

- Mandatory participation in educational or work experience programs for 20 hours weekly
- Severe penalties for non-compliance, including a three-year ban on assistance for those missing three consecutive months
- Increased demand is anticipated in coming months. There will be ongoing collaboration with Board of Social Services to address these changes

Committee Updates

Arc of Camden County

Meghan Lynne

- Arc of Camden County hired two new team members and expanded services to Delaware, with plans to open in more states by year-end

Popcorn for the People

Theresa Santana

- Popcorn for the People added remote sales staff in Tennessee
- Pre-vocational training programs will be launching in Philadelphia and New Jersey

American Water

Jeanne Storm, Talent Acquisition Partner

- Jeanne discussed about the Water Up program and potential expansion to New Jersey, with plans for her to connect with American Water leadership. The company's merger with Essential was also addressed, confirming that headquarters will remain in Camden and operations will continue under the American Water name.
